6. It was decided to inspire teachers to participate in seminars, workshops and to arrange educational tours.

7. The activities conducted by different committees will be checked periodically by IQAC.

Outcome achievement by the end of the academic year:-

1. Admission committee worked effectively for the admission of the students for different

faculties. They had guided students about different courses and subject combinations available in our college, various scholarships, fees structure, etc.

2. Due to the principal's address at the beginning of academic year, made to students became

aware of the discipline, cultural and social activities, evaluation methods, different plan to achieve academic excellence, new courses introduced etc by the college.

3. Due to annual teaching plan and daily teaching report, the syllabus was completed

effectively according to the plan. This plan helped to students for planning of the study and to secure maximum marks in internal evaluation system.
